

Ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> for children ages 1-14 years.







#### Drowning Volume by Month YTD Mar 2019








## Drownings by Location and Year 2016-2019 (Jan-Mar)




#### CY 2019 Drownings by Age



#### 2018 Lifeguard Your Child Campaign Highlights

Awareness	<b>200,000</b> Water Watcher Tags distributed as a tool to remind adults to provide in-reach supervision without distraction during swim time.
Education	<b>2,513</b> parents and <b>18,153</b> children educated by partners using our Water Safety Pre-K Pack. This resulted in <b>690</b> families and <b>1,450</b> children enrolling in Cook Children's Water Safety Club.
Layers of Protection	Campaign partners supported the Water Safety Club, ensuring families have access to safety. <b>360</b> children completed water safety lessons, <b>428</b> life jackets were distributed, and many have participated in CPR lessons. Year round incentives also include child/pool alarm systems, pool fencing equipment.
Cook Children's Media Report	<b>8.14M</b> reached via social media, <b>3.43M</b> total video views, <b>803</b> posts, and <b>21M</b> impressions through paid digital media.
YMCA Pilot	The YMCA graciously partnered with Cook Children's to pilot a program that directly links water safety with school students. The two schools identified for the pilot, Uplift Mighty Elementary and Mitchell Elementary, are in walking distance to the new, McDonald YMCA / Fort Worth. Dry land water safety education was provided to 1,880 students this year and swim lessons will be provided to 1st graders at these two schools during the 2018-2019 school year.

The Lifeguard Your Child campaign is now trademarked for use by other organizations across the country.










#### Poisoning Volume by Month YTD Feb 2019








#### 2019 Poisoning Volume by Age Group YTD Feb 2019




