Recommended Questions to Ask Your Insurance Provider:

- Does my policy cover ABA (Applied Behavior Analysis) services?
- Is there a limited number of ABA therapy hours covered through insurance that my child is able to receive yearly?
- Is there a co-pay for services, or out-of-pocket amount?
- Do I need a prescription and/or referral from my physician for ABA services?
- Is the desired provider in-network with my plan?
- Do I need pre-authorization from my insurance company before I schedule ABA services?
