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### What is a research registry?

A research registry is a database used to connect eligible research participants and their families with research opportunities. It consists of basic characteristic questions and contact information so that eligible participants can be easily identified and contacted when studies begin recruitment.

- If you participate in a study, you may be compensated for your time and effort
