## Medicaid Health Care Services

**All children and young adults age 20 and younger in managed care receive the same traditional Medicaid services. Some of those services are things such as:**

- Doctor and clinic visits
- 24-hour emergency care
- Hospital care
- Surgery
- Ambulance service
- Lab and X-ray services
- Major organ transplants
- Hearing tests and aids
- Home health services
- Community First Choice
- Personal Care Services
- Podiatrists (foot doctors)
- Help for drug or alcohol problems
- Dialysis for kidney problems
- Family planning services
- Eye checkups, glasses, and contact lenses
- Shots
- Texas Health Steps medical and dental checkups
- No limit on medicines Mental health services (such as counseling)
- Chiropractors (neck and back doctors)
- Private Duty Nursing

**People on the MDCP waiver can receive the following services:**

- Adaptive aids
- Minor home modifications
- Transition assistance services
- Employment assistance
- Flexible family support services
- Financial management services
- Respite services
- Supported employment

Extra Help Getting a Ride	Bus tokens for doctor visits or health classes.	
Extra Vision Services	Fitting checkup and 20 percent off certain contact lenses, up to \$100 each year, for members 12 and older.	\$125 for prescription eyeglasses (frames and lenses) or \$75 for contact lenses, including fitting fees.
Sports and School Physicals		One sports/school physical in addition to a checkup per calendar year to enrolled members ages 3 through 18.
Temporary phone help	Unlimited text messaging for members enrolled in the Federal Lifeline Program including free health education messages from Text4Babies, Text4Kids, and Text4Health.	
Help for Members with Asthma	Up to a \$100 per year incentive for enrolling in asthma disease management program.	
Healthy Play and Exercise Programs		Up to \$200 per member per enrollment year towards the enrollment of an accredited special health needs camp.
